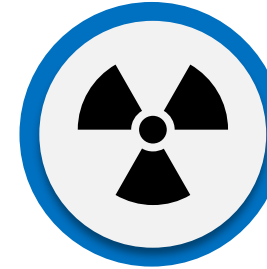

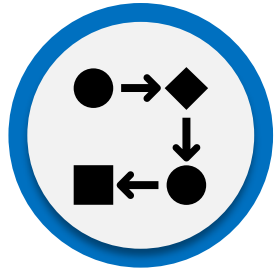

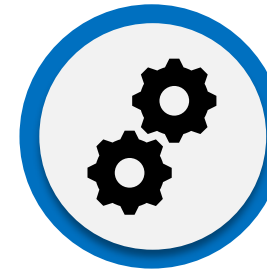
NO STRUCTURED WORKFLOW

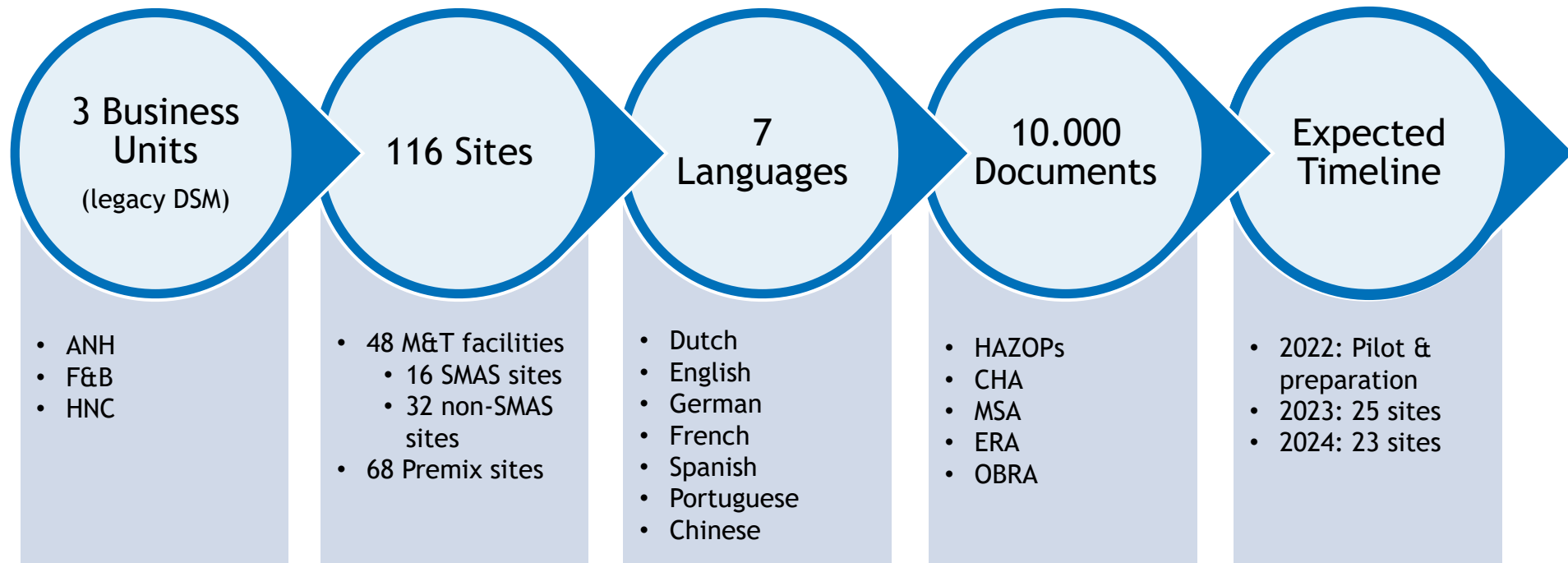

Importance of Alignment in Early Stages

- Understanding underlying business needs and processes (not software features) of DSM first was critical to the project
- Working towards being a solution partner vs being 'just' a software provider.
- Open, transparent communication, feedback as well as hands on 'risk template' mockups helped keep the project consistently focused on the key goals and end user needs.

Configuration vs Customization: the Cloud balancing act

Working with a world class company like dsm-firmenich brings a lot of benefit to a PSM project of this sort.

- + Mature, well documented global Process Safety Management workflow
- + Well trained and engaged PSM teams following the established workflow
- + Many subject matter experts



For a software provider, there is a balance between configuring the software solution to the process (easy and proper) vs. ‘customizing’ specific code tools in the short term.



There is a balance between the short-term items against software development roadmap. Vendors want to meet as much as possible, but it is not always feasible.



Close Collaboration Benefits: Solution Maturation
